Ordinance to lower speed limit on town highway

ORDINANCE NO: 2013-04

The Town Board of the Town of Sumner, Barron County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective December 1, 2013, speed limits on certain Town of Sumner town highways are reduced or modified as follows: the speed limit on $15\frac{1}{2} 16^{th}$ Avenue starting at 24 ½ Street (CTH M) and ending at 30^{th} Street (County Line Road) shall be reduced to 45 miles per hour.
- B. Pursuant to s. <u>349.11 (5)</u>, Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. <u>346.60</u>, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on December 1, 2013.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
