PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- Furnish and install three 36"x 46' Aluminized steel culverts & one 24"x 46 Aluminized' steel culvert. Culvert bedding & backfill, Compacted shall meet standard specifications.
- Remove and replace sub road base material in low or sunken road areas marked (A): 60'x24' & area (B):85'x24'. Remove 20" in depth below existing road surface and replace with 12" of 3" Dense Grade Base, compacted over MIRAFI HP370 geotextile fabric or equal. Reinstate road base with 8" of 1 1/4" Dense Grade Base gravel compacted. Contractor shall remove and dispose of all substandard sub base material and asphalt from excavated areas.

The work schedule shall be as proposed by the Bidder, but shall be completed no latter then Dec.31 2024. *The final schedule will be mutually agreed to by the Town of Sumner and the Successful bidder.*
