## Town of Sumner- Town Board Meeting

Tuesday, October 8, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. Town Hall, 1550 24½ Street, Town of Sumner, Wisconsin

- 1. <u>Call to order:</u> Chair Palmquist. Supervisors Zimmer and Tubbs attending.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance: Recited
- 3. Verification of proper public notice. Clerk Tomczak
- 4. Approval of Agenda by Board. Moved Zimmer/Tubbs to approve. No negative vote.
- 5. Open Bids for Asphalt Paving Project on 15 1/2-16th Ave. A bid was received from Monarch Paving Company: \$354760.05. Moved Zimmer/Tubbs to accept the bid from Monarch Paving. No negative vote.
- 6. Reports and Correspondence: Treasurer, reconciliation report given; Clerk; Board agrees that budget reports can be made quarterly, town property tax levy was met after August settlement entry. 150<sup>th</sup> celebration event revenue=\$13, 607; expense \$8,172, reminder to the board of requirements to enroll employees, board members and appointed officials into the Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS); correspondence shared. Patrolman; will remove netting from ball field fence for winter, constructing turn-arounds on dead-end roads. Zoning would approve plans to allow town to make cemetery improvements in county ROW near cemetery, disagreed with how WRS reminders were given. Board Members: Mark Zimmer: town might be able to borrow money from the foundation to pay for a short-term loan to pay for the road project until the grant money is received.
- 7. Minutes of September Meetings: Moved Tubbs/Zimmer to accept. No negative vote.
- 8. <u>Informal Public Comment.</u> Dave Mansfield asked why were the checks from the foundation not cashed by the town?
- 9. <u>Discuss progress/cost of blade patching and shouldering done this year.</u> 27<sup>th</sup> St South done with wedge patch will be getting a bill for \$100,100 from Barron County Highway Dept.
- 10. <u>Discuss 2-year road plan.</u> Zimmer recommended switching to plastic culverts for the Old 14 project, savings of \$3,000. Moved Tubbs/Palmquist to approve the switch. No negative vote. Will begin to pulverize the old blacktop soon.
- 11. Repairs to bridge P-03-84 on 27<sup>th</sup> St just north of 17<sup>th</sup> Ave intersection. Mats were installed to improve stability on the bridge until permanent repairs made.
- 12. <u>Discuss cemetery beautification project.</u> A spring 2025 project. Zoning will approve plan or not.
- 13. <u>Resolution 2024-04 Adjust 2024 Budget Category for Cemetery.</u> Move Tubbs/Zimmer that we move \$1000 from Other Financing Uses to Cemetery category. No negative vote.
- 14. 2025 budget. Discussed and board said it was OK to post as is.
- 15. <u>Canton Park Committee</u>: Report and requests. The committee would like christmas lights put up, ACC has more to do.
- 16. <u>Items intended for future meetings.</u> Old 14 project, Repairs to bridge P-03-84 on 27<sup>th</sup> St just north of 17<sup>th</sup> Ave intersection. 2-year road plan, 27<sup>th</sup> St going south??or north? Bid to open.
