Call to order: Acting⁶ Chair Supervisor Zimmer. Supervisor Tubbs attending.

Pledge of Allegiance: Recited

Approval of Agenda by Board. Moved Tubbs/Zimmer to approve. No negative vote.

Reports and Correspondence: Treasurer gave reconciliation report. Clerk gave year-end balance sheet report, correspondence shared. Patrolman reported on work done.

Informal Public Comment. Dave Mansfield: Foundation Meeting went well. The Town might get the \$125,000 requested.

Letter from Land Information-Zoning: revisions to the Rezoning Application review/submittable process. The revisions require a review of the rezoning application by the Zoning office prior to applicant appearing at a town board meeting. Discussed.

Bid out seal coating on 27th Street south of US 8. Zimmer/Tubbs moved that we bid that out. No negative vote.

Bid out seal coating on 16th Ave going east from 27th Street to within 1000' of bridge. County will do the blade patching before the seal coating. Moved Tubbs/Zimmer to bid out seal coating on 16th ave going east from 27th Street to within 1000' of bridge. No negative vote.

Bid out paving on & adjacent to bridge north of 27th Street and 17th Ave intersection. Moved Tubbs/Zimmer to go ahead and bid out paving on & adjacent to bridge north of 27th Street and 17th Ave intersection. No negative vote.

Bid out striping on 16th Avenue & 27th Street. Moved tubbs/Zimmer to bid out striping on 16th Avenue & 27th Street. No negative vote.

Proposed change to intersection of 16th Ave and 27th Street from a 2-way stop to a 4-way stop. Patrolman Svoma's stated the intersection is dangerous for large equipment. Board needs more research before a decision is made.

Purchase or adjust services from Cintas for uniforms, rugs, supplies, or purchase uniforms rugs etc. Svoma said we can buy uniforms outright, board wants prices before decision.

Canton Park Committee: Report and requests. Planning a wooden bat & vintage baseball event for August 15 and 16.

Items intended for future meetings. Plan commission appointments, 4-way stop sign at intersection of 16th Ave and 27th Street, change from rental and cleaning of rugs and uniforms to outright purchase from Cintas.
